【英語学研究】

英語を日本語や世界の諸言語と適切に対照しながら、英語史や英語の音声学・音韻論、形態論、表記法などを考察して英語を言語学的に分析し、英語の語彙層、語源学、歴史的な変化、そして様々な英語の変種の幅広い多様性などについて探求する。

【 Aural-Oral Practice & Theory 】

音声学と音韻論を基礎にし、正確かつ自然な英語発音を重視しながら、英語の音素の正確な感知や調音の能力獲得を目指し、英語の音構造に対する理解を深める。日本語や諸言語の音との比較、様々な英語の地域的な音の差異、通常の連続発話で起こる音変化なども考察する。

Linguistics, whether contrastive linguistics or focusing specifically on English (or other languages), is a fascinating area of study that allows us to learn ever more about how human language works and become increasingly aware of our own day-to-day language usage, as well as that of others. Each of the various subfields of linguistics offers valuable insights: phonetics, phonology, morphology, morphophonology, syntax, morphosyntax, semantics, pragmatics, discourse analysis, sociolinguistics, psycholinguistics, historical linguistics, comparative linguistics, contrastive linguistics, and others. My personal areas of specialization include phonetics, phonology, historical and contrastive linguistics, and translation studies, but regardless of subfield, linguistics is a truly fascinating and rewarding field!
